# "Spiritual Shape"

Most of us are fairly conscientious when it comes to our physical health. We try to watch what we eat and work to maintain a healthy lifestyle through exercise, diet, and rest. Some of you walk, run, bike, treadmill, swim, do cross fit, Pilates, yoga, aerobics, or lift weights.



We are good at concentrating on our physical bodies, but do you ever think about exercising your spiritual muscles? The spiritual body, like the physical body, needs to be exercised. I find that unless the spirit is nurtured and stimulated, it is easy to become complacent in our walk with Jesus Christ.

The season of Lent, the 40 days leading up to Easter, provides a good time to work on our spiritual lives. ### **Session Notes:**

The Session met on Thursday, February 13, 2024 The session welcomed new Elders, Erin Heringer and Ernie Watters. The proposed budget for the year 2024 of \$562,719 was approved by the session.

Sandi Schoenberger was approved to represent the session at the March Presbytery meeting at First Presbyterian Church on March 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.

A proposal for building a retaining wall along the East and South sides of the church to prohibit water leakage into the preschool was approved.

The Presbyterian Women's organization in our church has five different groups which meet monthly for study, fellowship, and often food. # Church and Society class schedule for March

Our Church and Society Sundays at 9:30 AM in the Church & Society Room. A different guest present every week. Here is the lineup for March:

MARCH 3: Fawn Reed, Legal and Victim Services Administrator at YWCA Billings. She will talk about "Hope for Those Fleeing Domestic Violence." The YWCA provides the only shelter in Billings and Hardin for victims of domestic violence in a seven-county region covering 18,512 square miles. Fawn will discuss the programs for these victims and those of sexual assault and stalking. Advocates, case managers, a housing navigator, and a legal advocate provide these services at no cost. Fawn will also provide information about the new Family Justice Center project.

**MARCH 10:** Valarie Weber, Director of the Ted Lechner Youth Services Center. When working with two boys from Pine Hills 32 years ago, Valarie realized she loved working with delinquent kids. In her 28 years as director Val will talk about programs offered and answer questions about juvenile justice and youth violence.

**MARCH 17:** Olena Henley, native of Ukraine, will talk about "Revisiting my Homeland." Traveling to Ukraine last summer to visit her family who chose to stay, Olena will share Ukrainians' perspectives of the war. She will also detail the changes she has observed in the landscape and in the people since the war began.

MARCH 24: Mike Penfold, Retired Director of the BLM in Montana, North and South Dakota, and Alaska. "Tragedies and the Afterlife on the Bozeman Trail." Two children who died 12,000 years apart on the Bozeman Trail were buried with evidence of belief in the afterlife. In addition to studying the history of the Bozeman Trail, Mike has walked most of it with the goal of producing an accurate map and designation as a Historical Trail.
